Chairman Cannon called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

MOTION: **Rep. Shirts** made a motion to approve the minutes of February 26, 2026. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 33577: **Sen. Den Hartog** presented **RS 33577**, which revises the sales tax exemption for data centers by revising eligibility requirements, adding reporting obligations to the Tax Commission, requiring compliance certifications related to water and electricity use, and allowing each qualifying project to receive the exemption for up to 20 years. During debate, members questioned the accelerated April 1 effective date and whether the bill was intended to benefit a specific project. The sponsor clarified that the date was chosen to avoid impacting a project currently under construction and to ensure existing projects remain subject to the law in effect at the time they began.

MOTION: **Rep. Raybould** made a motion to introduce **RS 33577**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:06 AM.
