The White House Office of Intergovernmental Affairs strongly supports Idaho Senate Bill 1441. The bill establishes full participation in the 287(g) program, empowering state and local law enforcement to enforce some aspects of U.S. federal immigration law. The 287(g) program dramatically expands U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) reach and keep Idaho communities safe from dangerous illegal criminal aliens.

Under President Trump, the 287(g) program has seen historic growth, making America safer and stronger. We commend the Idaho Legislature for its commitment to keeping Idahoans safe and ensuring accountability within the immigration system. We encourage swift passage of this important measure.
