**Chairman Crane (13)** called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Dygert** made a motion to approve the minutes of Tuesday March 31, 2026. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**SCR 127:** **Rep. Monks** presented **SCR 127**. This legislation addresses the devastating impact the legalizing of marijuana has had on other states. Additionally, this legislation identifies the significant problems with The Idaho Medical Cannabis Act Ballot Initiative as it is currently written.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Skaug** made a motion to send **SCR 127** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation.

Committee members had comments and questions in regards to the intent of the resolution, ballot entries, free speech, solutions for cancer, state taxes and revenues, studies on generated money, affects of legalization of marijuana, mental illness, marijuana verses Kratom, and additional groups drawn into Idaho on an election year. Other committee members had comments and questions in regards to black market marijuana, increased traffic deaths, lies around tax revenues, permanent health decline in young men, saving future generations, produces homelessness, and negative changes in the State of Florida due to the legalization of medical marijuana.

**Kirk Hingsberger**, Self; spoke in opposition of **SCR 127**.

**Rep. Monks** stated projections of \$3.9 million dollars in revenue for the State of Idaho, not wanting Idaho to emulate any other state, and Utah's black market problems.
