HJR 2		Furniss(31)	by EDUCATION COMMITTEE - LIMITATIONS OF COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL INDEBTEDNESS - Proposes an amendment to the state constitution to revise the percentage of assent required during statewide election years.
H 416		Scott(2)	by STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE - STATE GOVERNMENT - Adds to existing law to prohibit the state government and its employees from paying membership fees or dues.
H 683		Raybould(34)	by EDUCATION COMMITTEE - OFFICE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES - Amends and adds to existing law to establish the Office of Early Childhood Services.
H 667		Kingsley(7)	by STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE - ELECTIONS - Amends existing law to revise provisions regarding voting by absentee ballot.

H 637	Tanner(14)	by WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - COUNTYWIDE HIGHWAY DISTRICTS - Repeals and adds to existing law to allow certain countywide highway districts to be divided into subdistricts, each represented by a commissioner.
H 506	Redman(3)	by BUSINESS COMMITTEE - SHORT-TERM RENTALS - Amends existing law to provide limitations on regulation of short-term rentals.
H 701	Burns(26)	by REVENUE AND TAXATION COMMITTEE - TAXATION - Amends existing law to provide for the proration of the homestead exemption based on the change in status of the property.
H 717	Burns(26) Ehlers(21)	by WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - TAXATION - Amends existing law to revise provisions regarding the burden of proof in assessments and to provide for the proration of the homestead exemption based on the change in status of a property.
