



Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

The Idaho Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired (ICBVI) was established in 1967. ICBVI assists individuals who are blind or visually impaired to achieve social and economic independence. The commission is organized under the Office of the Governor and consists of five appointed members who serve three-year terms. At least three of the commissioners must be blind or visually impaired. Statutory authority: Chapter 54, Title 67, Idaho Code.

Fig 1. Total Appropriation and Total Expenditures

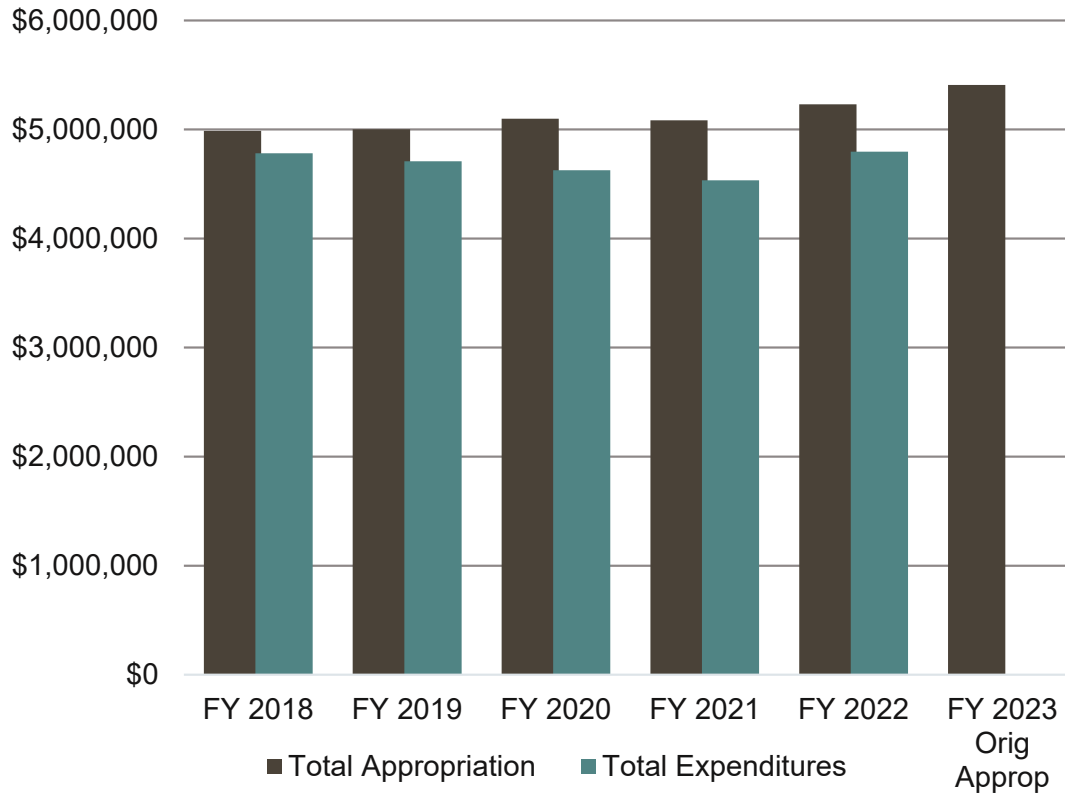


Fig 2. Current FTP Allocation – 41.12 FTP

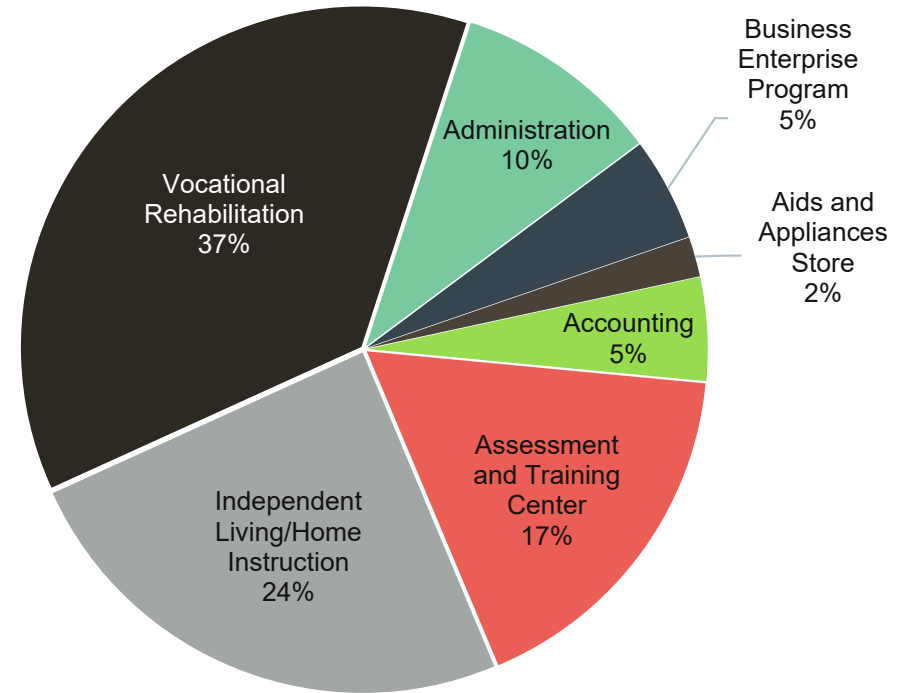


Fig 3. Trustee & Benefit Payment Expenditures
