

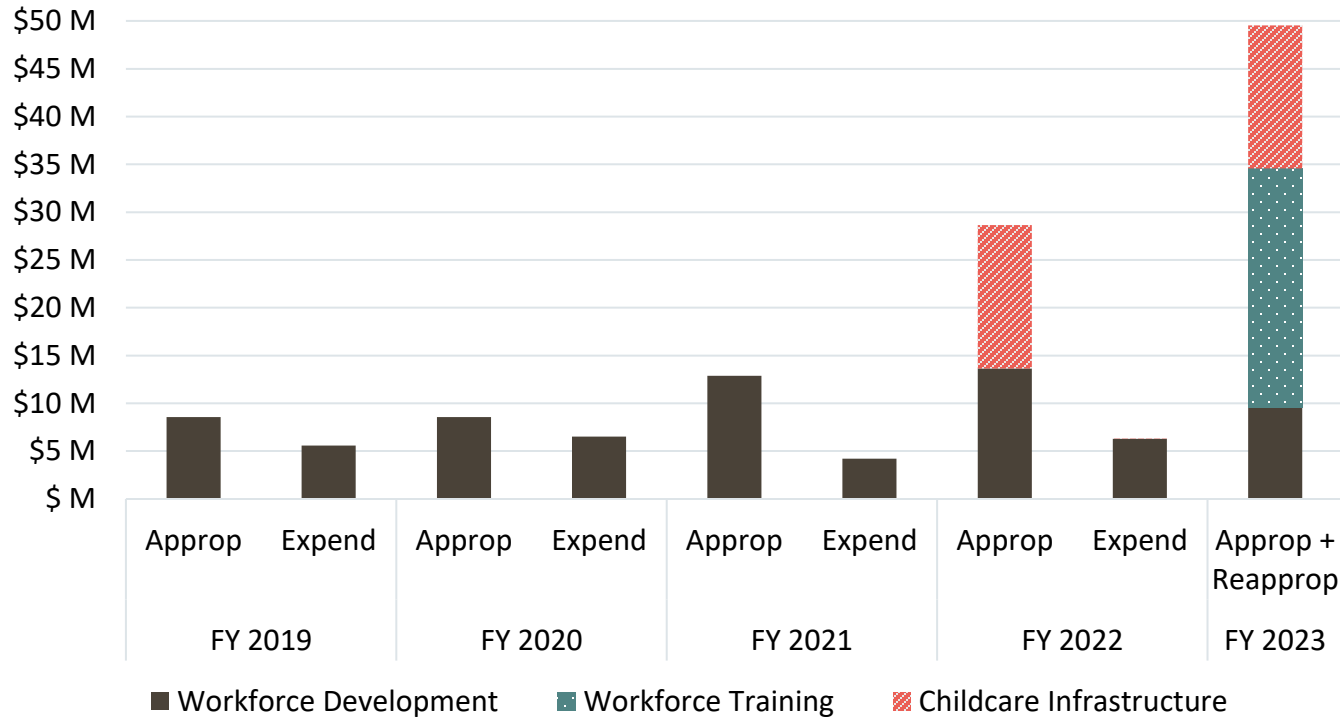


Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

Authorized in Section 72-1201, Idaho Code, the Workforce Development Council was created under the Office of the Governor through H432 of 2018.

- Workforce Development: Increase public awareness of, and access to, career education and training opportunities, to help maintain a highly skilled workforce.
- Workforce Training: Manage grants to provide access to training and apprenticeship for individuals and for providers offering training aligned to state needs.
- Childcare Infrastructure: Manage Childcare Infrastructure Grants intended to expand the number of childcare slots available in the state.

Total Appropriation vs Expenditures



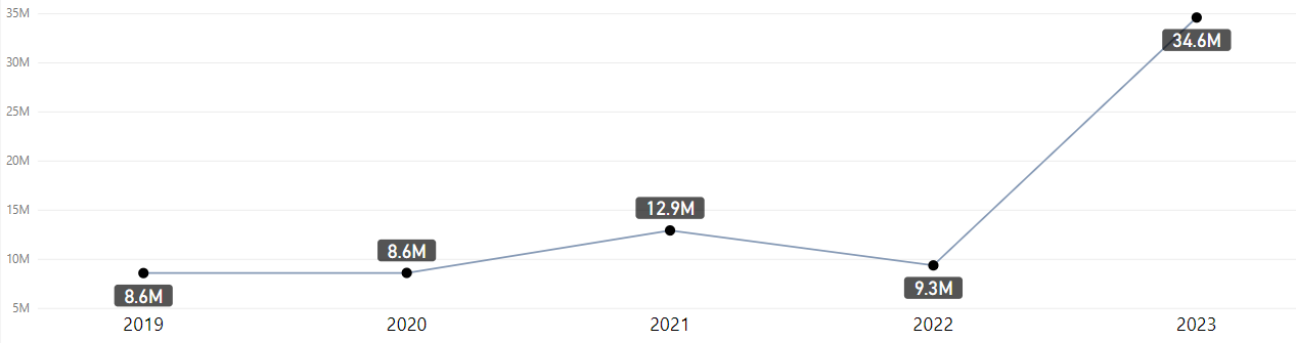
- No ongoing General Fund appropriation

- Federal fund sources - Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, American Rescue Plan Act, and other grants



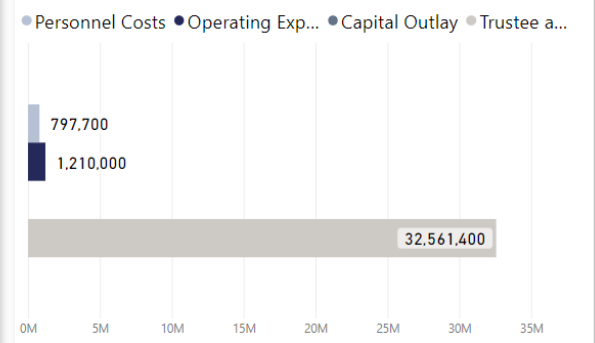

Original Appropriation by Fiscal Year



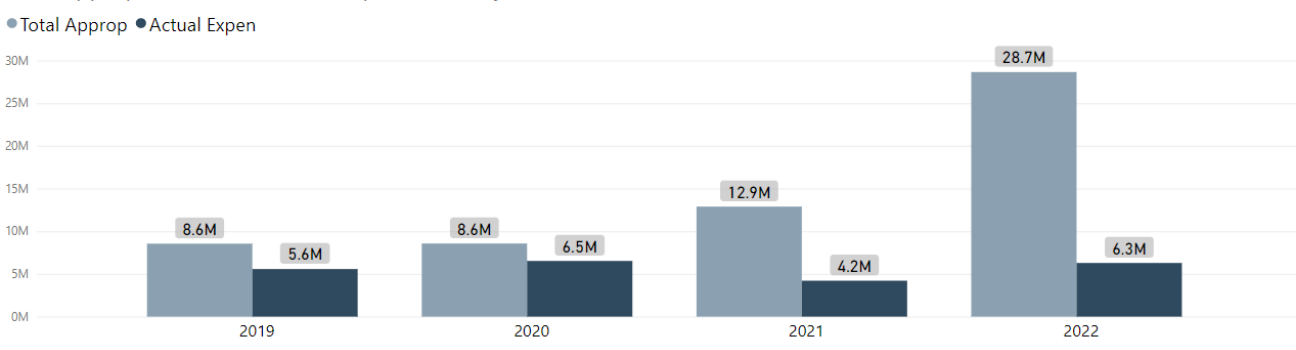
